



Type V Action – 19.01.005 CHMC

The following decisions are legislative: Adoption of development regulations and amendments, Area-wide rezones initiated by the city to implement new city policies, Adoption of the comprehensive plan and plan amendments and Annexations

- Any person can suggest amendments by providing a written request to the City. The fee is \$250 (non-refundable) for each petition (one petition for each parcel of land), plus actual costs incurred by the City in hiring outside consultants, including, but no limited to, attorneys.
- The City Administrator shall maintain for public review a list of suggested amendments and "identified deficiencies" to the comprehensive plan, and the city's development regulations
- The public shall be made aware of the opportunity to suggest amendments and to comment on suggested amendments. The procedure for submitting such amendments is attached.

19.08.030-Suggesting Amendments

The public has an opportunity to suggest amendments to the City's Comprehensive Plan by providing the following written information to the Clyde Hill City Administrator:

1. Name, address and telephone number of the person suggesting the amendment
2. Citation of the specific text, map or other illustration suggested to be amended
3. The suggested amendment
4. If a suggested amendment is to a plan or to both a plan and a development regulation, a statement of how the amendment:
 - A. Promotes the public health, safety and welfare
 - B. Is consistent with or in conflict with other portions of the comprehensive plan, which portions shall be cited by goal, policy and/or action reference number, and by page number; and
 - C. Complies with the applicable countywide planning policies
5. If a suggested amendment is only to the development regulations, a statement as to how the amendment complies with the comprehensive plan.
6. The fee is \$250 (non-refundable).
